



Sierra Wax Artists

Dear Sierra Wax Artist Member,

You're invited to enter the jury selection process for Sierra Wax Artists' fourth membership show. This is open to all Sierra Wax Artist members. The show will be juried by encaustic and mixed media artist, Barbara Nilsson, and installed at THE ARTHOUSE [1021 R Street, Sacramento - between 10th and 11th Streets]. Turn in your suggestion for a show title to our Facebook page until December 1. Sierra Wax Artist's membership show will run from February 9 through March 6, 2018. Get started now and consider submitting your most creative work.

Please note the following instructions and important dates.

- Entry fee is \$20.
- No commission will be taken. 100% of all sales go to the artist.
- Weight limit: 25 pounds.
- Each artist may submit **up to two pieces** – width size limit 2'. Height limit – 5'.
- Work submitted must be new and **not** shown previously in an SWA show.
- All submissions must be your own original artwork. No giclee work.
- All types of hot, cold and punic (Ceracolors) wax work accepted
- We are not responsible for artwork behind glass - Plexiglas is preferred.
- **ALL WORK MUST BE WIRED AND READY TO HANG. No sawtooth hangers.** (Please see next page for instructions.)
- Frames should be simple in color and size. Neutral color matting is preferred.
- SWA will create gallery tags with artist's name, art title, medium and price for each selected piece.
- ***ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE.***
- Artist's contact information will be available in the gallery during the show.
- All submitted work must include a completed tag provided below attached to the backside of each art piece. **Completed tags below are absolutely necessary. Please print clearly.**

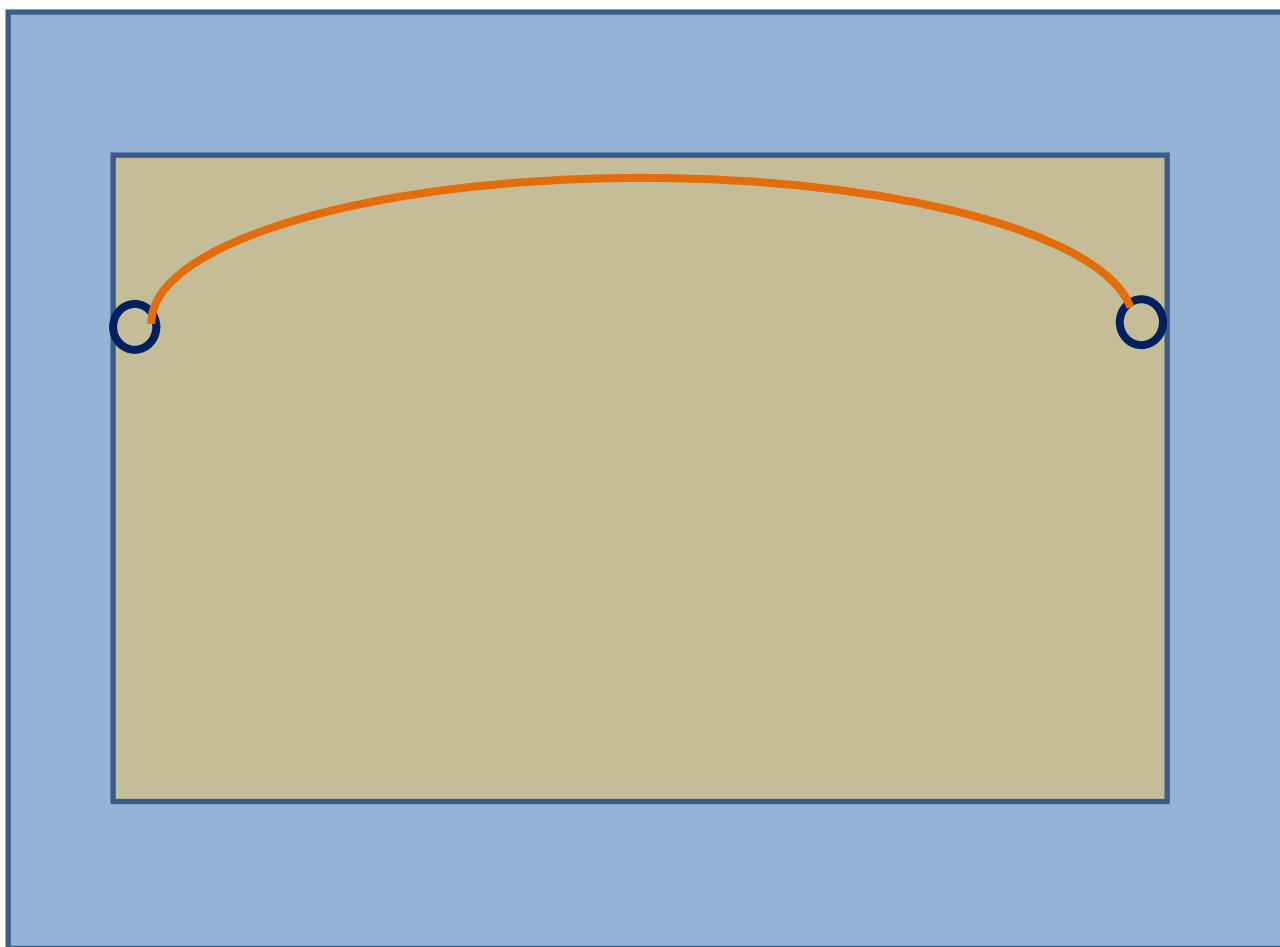

Framing and Wiring Your 2D Artwork

- Place the wire hardware (eyelet screws or D-rings) $\frac{1}{3}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ " down from top of frame. (These can be purchased at any hardware or framing store.)
- Screw these into the inside sides of frame.
- The wire should have approximately 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches wrapped around D-ring or eyelet screw. Run the wire through the D-ring or eyelet and then around itself down the wire, then back toward the frame.
- When the wire is taut in the center, it should be approximately 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches from the top of the frame.



BE SURE TO ATTACH YOUR ARTIST LABEL TO THE BACK SIDE OF EACH ARTWORK.
